

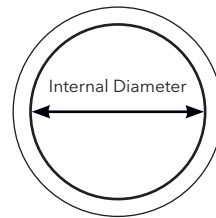
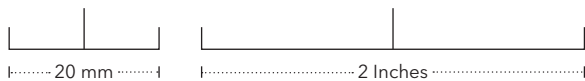
## Choosing your ring size

Please follow these instructions carefully to size your ring. Print this guide on an A4 size page. Make sure that it is printing at 100% by checking your print settings so that any page scaling options are set to 'none'.

Place a ring that perfectly fits your finger over the nearest ring size shown in the chart below. The inner edge of the ring should match the outer edge of the circle.

Use the scale below to test the actual size of your printed page, ensuring that the scale measures exactly 20mm or 2 inches long.

If your ring falls between two sizes shown, we recommend that you order the larger size.
